2. About This Release

Version 4.0.3 Build 112 is a service release to the bowbridge Anti-Virus – On Premises line of products.

3. Supported Operating Systems

This product has been tested on the following platforms or with the following products:

- Linux on x86_64 (SuSE Linux Enterprise Server 12 and 15, RedHat Enterprise Linux 7, 8 and 9)
- Linux on PPC64 LE - VSA client only (on SuSE Linux Enterprise Server 15SP2 or higher)

4. Upgrade Procedure

Upgrade from previous installations of bowbridge Anti-Virus 4.x is supported. A respective option is available in the installer.

To upgrade from an earlier major version, customers must install version 4.x parallel to the existing version and activate v4.x by reconfiguring the virus scan profile(s). After this step, the uninstall script provided with the previous version can disable and uninstall it.

5. New Features

The following new features are introduced in this release:

- Support for AMQP over HTTP

6. Bugs and Issues fixed

The following issues have been addressed in this release:

- Automatic cache invalidation and reloading of mime mappings and active-content configurations upon creation of new realm/SID-specific configuration files
- Improved starting order of processes. Workers now wait for the control-service to be started
- --tracefile-maxsize parameter being ignored in some workers
- Filename truncation in CDFv2 (.msg) file extraction

New Features:

- Scan Servers/clusters deployed on-premises can now utilize bowbridge cloud management
- bb-license now has a “checklicensestatus” option to verify if features are licensed for a given realm, SID, and hostname.

 - SCANEXTRACT_RATIO
 - SCANEXTRACT_SIZE
